COURSE INFORMATION

The Multi-Crew Pilot Licence (MPL) has been developed and implemented by ICAO specifically to train ab-initio airline pilots. The MPL is expected to be introduced worldwide as the standard entry licence for new pilots starting their airline careers.

Our course is one of the first in the world to obtain approval from the regulatory authorities. The training programme consists of an intensive six month ground school study of aviation theoretical subjects. The latest computer-based training technology is used and we have experienced instructors on hand to assist the cadets in understanding all that they need to know.

After the initial academic phase the cadet will be taught basic flying skills by completing 70 hours of structured flying in a single engine training aircraft.

Following this basic phase the cadet returns to the classroom for advanced learning and will undertake a further 170 hours of comprehensive instruction in the most sophisticated aircraft flight simulators available.

The cadet is assisted in developing all the Airbus A320 flying skills necessary for entry into airline service by our experienced Airline Training Captains.

On successful completion of the programme, the cadet will be awarded his/her "wings" and be ready to start one of the most exciting careers in the world.

1. Possess a sufficient level of education at higher level in order to permit on schedule assimilation of the theoretical and practical knowledge requirements of the course
2. Possess a sufficient competency of the English language

Please be advised that successful applicants will be required to provide documentary evidence of their academic qualifications.

Provided that the applicant meets the minimum requirements you will be invited to attend one of our assessment days. The day consists of an English language and psychometric test plus a computer based aptitude and co-ordination analysis.

Following successful assessment applicants must then undertake a Class 1 Medical Examination with the applicable aviation authority in order to ensure that they qualify medically to be issued with a professional pilot licence.
